JJ. devised and bequeathed the same to his brother W. Gott, his 1872 heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, for his and their Allan absolute use and benefit. The testator died in April, 1867. William Gott, the residuary devisee and legatee, died in his lifetime. The present suit having been instituted by W. Allan, the surviving trustee, and his wife, w...
